

- (iii) The on-going project (s), sanctioned up to March, 2012, shall be completed within the extended period of JNNURM for implementation of projects within 2 years (up to March, 2014), failing which the State (s) would fund incomplete project (s) after 31.03.2014 out of their own resources.
- (iii) ACA committed for new projects and capacity building activities under UIG and UIDSSMT during transitional arrangement, i.e. till next phase of JNNURM is launched, shall be subsumed under the 12<sup>th</sup> Plan inter-State allocations as may be decided by the Planning Commission.
