





(iii) The on-going project (s), sanctioned up to March, 2012, shall be completed within the extended period of JNNURM for implementation of projects within 2 years (up to March, 2014), failing which the State (s) would fund incomplete project (s) after 31.03.2014 out of their own resources.

(iii) ACA committed for new projects and capacity building activities under UIG and UIDSSMT during transitional arrangement, i.e. till next phase of JNNURM is launched, shall be subsumed under the 12th Plan inter-State allocations as may be decided by the Planning Commission.

(iv) Due assessment of inter- State equity as per the Planning Commission suggested criteria referred to Para-12 of Annexure -7 of the Note for CCEA approving proposal to mandate continuation of JNNURM to sanction new projects and capacity- building activities till 31st March, 2014 under UIG and UIDSSMT is being carried out by MoUD.
