Dear Sir / Madam,

As you are aware, the first instalment for the Swachh Bharat Mission(SBM) is being released to the States based on the brief Concept Note on state sanitation strategy which is at Annexure IV of the Swachh Bharat Mission guidelines. The guidelines also stipulate that the States have to simultaneously start preparing City Sanitation Plans(CSP) for each city and State Sanitation Strategy as these will be required before any further release can be made to the States.

2. A template for the CSP has been placed at website [swachhbharaturban.gov.in](http://swachhbharaturban.gov.in) which will assist you in making the CSP. Regarding the State Sanitation Strategy (SSS) for SBM, since Annexure IV of the guidelines which required the States to submit a concept note on State Urban sanitation strategy has essentially captured the SSS for SBM, it is therefore felt that the States may now explain in no more than 500 words each for each component of the SBM, how they envisage to fulfil the objectives of SBM and to ensure that the targets are met. A table requesting this information for the approach for SSS is given at Annexure II.

3. I shall be grateful if both the CSP(on the website) and the approach paper (as annexed) for SSS is sent early to enable us to release the subsequent instalments as and when they become due.
